

Riley Green Renews Global Publishing Deal With Warner Chappell Music

Riley Green has renewed his global publishing deal Warner Chappell Music (WCM) Nashville.

The release of his 2019 debut album, *Different 'Round Here*, kicked off Green's career trajectory. The project features 3x Platinum-certified "I Wish Grandpas Never Died" and 2x Platinum "There Was This Girl." In 2020, he was crowned Best New Male Artist of the Year at the ACM Awards and was named *MusicRow's* Breakout Artist of the Year.

In 2024 he dropped his third studio album, *Don't Mind If I Do*, which featured collaborations with Luke Bryan and Ella Langley. The collaboration with Langley, "you look like you love me," took home Single, Song, and Music Video of the Year at the 2025 CMA Awards.

Green has kicked off this year with back-to-back No. 1 hits "Don't Mind If I Do" featuring Langley and "Worst Way." "Worst Way" became Green's sixth career No. 1, and made him the first country music artist to achieve consecutive solo-written No. 1 singles on the *Billboard* Country Airplay chart since Taylor Swift.

Green is currently on his 2026 "[Cowboy As It Gets Tour](#)," with scheduled stops in Charlotte, Saratoga Springs, Green Bay and more through August. He will also make festival appearances at [Gulf Coast Jam](#), [CMA Fest](#), [Country Thunder Saskatchewan](#), and more throughout the summer. **MR**

Tucker Wetmore Wins ACM New Male Artist Of The Year

Tucker Wetmore has been crowned ACM’s New Male Artist of the Year. This marks Wetmore’s first-ever ACM Award.

Wetmore was surprised with the news in London last week during his sold-out show at the O2 Forum Kentish Town. **Thomas Rhett** appeared on screen via video message to announce the win before Wetmore’s mom **Sia** presented him with the trophy on stage.

“I’m at a loss for words right now for the first time in a long time. I can’t do any of this without you guys,” Wetmore shared from the stage. “I can’t do any of this without that woman [mom] right there... Y’all made this possible. Every single person in this venue. And there’s countless more outside of this venue that I can’t sit here and name because I’d be here all night. Thank y’all so much and thank you ACMs for this amazing honor.”

Wetmore is currently amidst his “[The Brunette World Tour](#),” selling out shows in New York, Boston, three consecutive nights in London and more, and he will also make his Red Rocks debut this summer.

The [61st ACM Awards](#) will stream live Prime Video on May 17 at 7 p.m. CT from MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas. **MR**

Stephen Wilson Jr. has been awarded his first ACM Award for Visual Media of the Year for his “[Cuckoo](#)” official video, which he co-directed with his longtime creative collaborator **Tim Cofield**.

Wilson Jr. was surprised with the award by ACM Head of Artist Relations **Haley Montgomery** at WXPN’s NON-COMMvention Wednesday (May 6).

Wilson Jr.’s latest single “Gary” just broke the top 40 on *Billboard’s* Country Airplay chart. He recently wrapped the entirely sold-out first leg of his “Gary The Torch Tour” and announced a [second leg](#) with added West Coast, Southeast and international dates. In between headline dates, he will support Dave Matthews Band at the Gorge Amphitheater and Brandi Carlile at Red Rocks Amphitheatre. **MR**

Frank Rogers Receives South Carolina's Highest Honor

CEO of Spirit Music and President of Fluid Music Revolution **Frank Rogers** received his home state's highest honor on April 30 as the Honorable **Henry McMaster**, Governor of South Carolina, presented him with the Order of the Palmetto.

As a producer, Rogers' work has resulted in 46 No. 1 singles and over 80 top twenty singles, with more than 40 singles and 20 albums being certified by the RIAA as Diamond, multi-Platinum, Platinum or Gold. He has amassed 18 CMA award nominations with one win, and 27 ACM award nominations with five wins. He was awarded *MusicRow's* Producer of the Year four times, and *Billboard's* No. 1 Hot Country Producer honor five times.

As a songwriter, Rogers has had songs recorded by artists such as Brad Paisley, Darius Rucker, Josh Turner, among others. He has earned 10 No. 1 tracks, including the [recent chart-topper](#) "Bottle Rockets," recorded by Scotty McCreery and Hootie and the Blowfish. He has received 16 ASCAP Songwriter Awards to date.

As an executive, Rogers is the former VP of EMI Nashville Productions where he signed artists including Brad Paisley and Darryl Worley. In 1999, Rogers opened up Sea Gayle Music with Paisley and Chris DuBois where he signed artists including Chris Stapleton and Ingrid Andress. In 2016, he opened Fluid Music Revolution and in 2019 he was named the CEO of Spirit Music Nashville. In 2022, Rogers was named Chief Creative Officer for Spirit Music and in 2025 rose to CEO of Spirit Music. **MR**

The War and Treaty have signed with Atlantic Outpost, first reported by [Billboard](#).

Alongside the signing, the duo have revealed their new album, *The Story of Michael and Tanya*, will be released on June 19. The 10-track project features collaborations with **Whoopi Goldberg**, **Valerie June** and **Wynonna**. The first track from the album, “Don’t Say Goodbye,” is out now.

“Evoking hard, honest emotions first required me to find those parts in myself,” **Tanya Trotter** shared to [Billboard](#). “Once you find them, there’s a strength to the urgency that feels like you’ll be at your wits’ end if you don’t express that emotion.”

The husband and wife duo are two-time Grammy nominees, and were crowned Emerging Artist of the Year in 2019 at the Americana Music Honors & Awards. In 2022, they were named Duo/Group of the Year at the same awards, as well as in 2023.

Also in 2023, The War and Treaty hit No. 14 on the [Billboard](#) Hot 100 with Zach Bryan collaboration “Hey Driver.” [Billboard](#) also honored them in 2024 with the Groundbreaker Award. They released their last album, *Plus One*, in 2025.

The War and Treaty have also slated a headlining show at the Ryman Auditorium on Sept. 13. [Tickets](#) go on sale May 15. **MR**
